Fermented in very cool temperatures and longer than normal hang time, this enjoyable summer wine brings out fruit offerings of honeydew with green apple and a citrus finish. A medium bodied wine, Naked pairs well with cold asparagus and a lemon mustard dressing or apple pie ala mode.
